Scholarships funded through the Dublin High School Music Booster Program are awarded to deserving graduating seniors that are active members of the DHS Music Program. Scholarships are awarded to qualified applicants who are continuing their education in a vocational school, Junior College or four-year College or University. Scholarships may also be awarded to graduating seniors who enlist in any branch of the United States Military and go into active service following graduation. Scholarships shall be presented to the scholarship recipients at the Dublin High School Senior Awards Night.

Each scholarship award will be based on the following criteria:

1. A current member of any component of the music program supported by the DHS Music Boosters
2. A minimum of two (2) years of participation in the Music program
3. A cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better
4. A positive activity record in school and/or community
5. A well-defined plan for the future
6. Strong recommendations
7. A well written and personally insightful essay

Each candidate wishing to apply for a scholarship under this program must submit the following:

1. A completed application
2. A high school transcript current through the end of the 1st semester of their senior year
3. One written recommendation from a teacher, counselor, employer, religious leader or responsible adult who has supervised their school or community service. There can only be one letter of recommendation from any of the above as chosen by the applicant.
4. The application must include a personal, well written essay, describing how the music program has influenced the person you are today and your goals for the future.
